The Union Symphony Youth Orchestra is an educational component to the Union Symphony Orchestra and is the only auditioned orchestral performance ensemble for students in Union County. Members rehearse and perform quality orchestral literature throughout the season. The first requirement of membership is dedication to the orchestra and commitment to its quality performances.

The season begins with an orchestra camp and a concert held on June 18–June 22. Rehearsals are held on Sundays between September and May from 2:30–5pm at Marvin Ridge High School. The USYO rehearsal and performance schedule can be found at usyo.org.

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner for all rehearsals and performances. They are expected to arrive on time with music stand, music binder, all materials and music; maintain a strong work ethic during rehearsal; and exhibit commitment to practice individual parts at home. Unexcused absences, excessive talking or disruptive behavior will result in removal from the orchestra.
